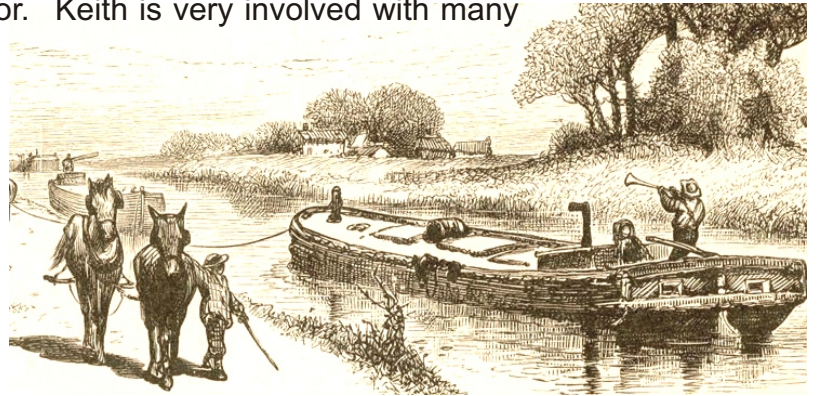


The C&D Canal and Frenchtown Railroad

In 1830, the Summit Bridge was the most elevated covered bridge in the Nation! The New Castle/Frenchtown RR was the 1st railroad built in Delaware and only the 3rd in America!
