As we round out the first year in our official Pencader Heritage Museum, PHAA is pleased with the activities we have been able to accomplish. The Speakers Series was re-instituted after several months with interesting and dynamic speakers. Great speakers have been lined up for the first few months of 2008. We are pleased that many visitors arrive with gifts and loans of artifacts for display. Antique farm and household tools, and additions to our files of Pencader's earliest families and family mementos continue to be donated or loaned. Deeds of Gift or Loan are given to the donors.

President Glenn Pusey and Vice-President Bill Conley have been invited several times to make presentations to various interest groups. Contact the website if you would like a speaker for your group.

Tentative plans are underway to establish a co-ed Pencader Venture Unit for Scouts who could earn badges and perhaps learn to be re-enactors as they absorb the history of Pencader Heritage Area. We hope to establish a Brownie Scout History Day where the girls could do hands-on learning and earn badges.

Our three nights of Ghost Hunting on the battlefield and around the old mill were a rousing success. We hope to present them again next fall.

On December 13, our first Student Leadership Conference was held at the museum. Twenty-four high school leaders spent the day hearing informative speakers on County government, scouting, State court systems, and the Delaware National Guard. The Guard provided MRE (meals-ready-to-eat) for lunch. These are the exact meals furnished to our service people in the field today. It was a true learning experience for students and adults. Press coverage was provided by the Newark Post.

PHAA had a special visitor in November. Morfudd Jones of the Pencader area of Wales, UK was our guest. She told us about her Pencader and learned about ours. We hope to establish a pen-pal relationship between elementary schools in the two Pencaders. Her visit was in honor of the Welsh immigrants who settled Pencader Hundred.
